

Steady Rollator Walker Carrier

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Easy Installation

1. Insert the T-Bar (A):

Slide the T-shaped bar into your vehicle's 1.25" hitch receiver. Lock it with your hitch pin.

2. Attach the L-Bar (B):


Insert the spring-loaded curved latch bar into the T-bar. Use the included linchpin to lock it into place — upright for use or horizontal for storage.

3. Adjust the Cradle Arms (C):

Slide the cradle arms onto each end of the T-bar. Align with your rollator's rear wheels before tightening.

4. Final Setup:

Secure the cradle arms using the included 7/16" bolts and lock nuts. These remain on the unit, even when the L-bar is removed.



Flip the T-bar to raise or lower the carrier height by 2 inches before installing the cradle arms.

Loading the Rollator

- 1. Turn the walker around so the rear wheels face the carrier.
- **2.** Tilt forward on the front wheels and lift the back wheels into the cradle arms.
- **3.** Fold the walker toward the vehicle the frame will rest securely.
- **4.** Lift the spring latch on the L-bar 2 inches and drop it over the walker frame to lock it in place.

Important Use Notes

- For wider frames, rotate the latch sideways to guide it between the rollator and vehicle.
- Do not continuously turn the latch in one direction

 it can snap the internal spring.
